7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 131-2021 TO HIRE AN
8 ADDITIONAL SECRETARY I AND ASSIGN THE POSITION TO THE
9 APPROPRIATE PAY GRADE IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE
10 COLLECTIVE BARGAINING AGREEMENT BETWEEN AMERICAN
11 FEDERATION OF STATE, COUNTY AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES
12 LOCAL 2662 AND THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, AND
13 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
14

15 WHEREAS, the Police Department requires an additional employee to aid in the fulfillment
16 of public records; and
17

18 WHEREAS, the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, and the Police Chief desire to add an
19 additional Secretary I to the Department.
20

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
22 State of Ohio, that:
23

24 Section 1. The position of Secretary I is hereby amended and placed in the American
25 Federation of State, County and Municipal Employees bargaining unit pay grade of A04.
26

27 Section 2. Subject to the sufficiency of annual or supplemental appropriations for personal
28 services in the Police Department, the Police Department shall be composed of the following
29 officers and other personnel (new text double underlined; deleted text in ~~strikethrough~~):
30

31 Officers:

- 32 1 Chief
- 33 2 Captains
- 34 4 Lieutenants
- 35 10 Sergeants
- 36 57 Patrol Officers

38 Other Personnel:

- 39 1 Secretary II
- 40 ~~2~~ 3 Secretary I
- 41 1 Juvenile Diversion Caseworker

43 This section shall not limit the Police Chief from hiring additional personnel in the Police
44 Department to replace anticipated vacancies where such vacancy is known and such overlap
45 does not exceed thirty (30) days.

47 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
48 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
49 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
50

51 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
52 relating to the adoption of this ordinance/resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this
53 Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in
54 such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements,
55 to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


56 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
57 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
58 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of
59 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately
60 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
61 earliest period allowed by law.
