12 13 14 15	WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and
16 17 18	WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.
19 20 21	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
22 23 24	<u>Section 1.</u> Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File is hereby amended as follows:
25 26 27	 Prohibit parking on the odd address side of Vancouver St. between 2031 and the dead end to the north.
28 29	2. Request to update the Traffic File to include the following items at the Blossom Glen subdivision:
30 31 32	 Stop sign on Ensemble Drive at Keyser Parkway Stop sign on Quartette Drive at Keyser Parkway Stop sign on Lyrics Lane at Keyser Parkway
33 34 35 36	 Stop signs on Symphony Street at both intersections with Keyser Parkway Stop sign on Keyser Parkway, northbound at West Steels Corners Road Install no parking signs on the even sides of Ensemble Drive, Quartette Lane and Symphony Street
37 38 39	 Install no parking signs on the even side of Keyser Parkway, between Chart Road and West Steels Corners Road
40 41 42	 3. Request to update the Traffic File to include the following item at the Timber Creek subdivision: Stop sign on Creekview Drive at Brookview Drive
43 44	Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to note in the Traffic Control File
45 46	the proper legends.

<u>Section 3.</u> The Mayor is hereby authorized to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
