## CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. | 9 - 2023

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, AS DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY, TO SELL TO SOURCE PRODUCTS, INC., CERTAIN USED FIRE DEPARTMENT EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, Source Products, Inc. is interested in purchasing used equipment that is no longer needed for use by the Cuyahoga Falls Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, in exchange for the equipment, the City will receive a \$4,000 credit to purchase medical supplies.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Mayor, as Director of Safety, is authorized to sell obsolete Fire Department equipment in exchange for a \$4,000.00 account credit to Source Products, Inc., to be used towards the purchase of medical supplies, by the Cuyahoga Falls Fire Department.

Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
