ORDINANCE NO. 15

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH MOODY'S OF DAYTON FOR WELL REPAIRS AND ADDITIONAL WELL SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, During the rehabilitation of City Well #19, Moody's of Dayton (Moody's) identified that major repairs were needed to put the well back into service; and

WHEREAS, Moody's was the lowest and most responsible bidder on the well flow testing and is familiar with the City's well system, including City Well #19; and

WHEREAS, although no specific expenditure for repairs in the City's well field has individually exceeded the threshold competitive bidding amount to date, collectively the expenditures may soon exceed the competitive bidding amount of \$75,000.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Moody's of Dayton for well repairs, including City Well #19 and additional well services in a total amount not to exceed \$125,000 for the 2024 fiscal year.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Water Fund, line items Capital Outlay and Other Operations.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

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
