ORDINANCE NO. 37 -2024

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO EXECUTE A MODIFICATION OF CONTRACT NO. 8879 WITH PERRIN ASPHALT COMPANY FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CURB ON SILVER LAKE AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance 117-2023, the City, after competitive bidding, entered into contract No. 8879 with Perrin Asphalt Company for the replacement of curb on Silver Lake Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to make additional repairs to curb on Silver Lake Avenue; and

WHEREAS, it is desired to use savings in the Storm Utility Fund to replace the additional curb on Silver Lake Avenue.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to execute a modification of Contract No. 8879 with Perrin Asphalt Company authorizing the replacement of curb on Silver Lake Avenue in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00. The total contract price after modification as authorized herein shall not exceed \$359,452.00.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same in an amount not to exceed \$250,000.00 from the Storm Drainage Utility Fund, line-item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

<u>Section 5.</u> This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
