14 Section 1. The Director of Law is hereby authorized to execute a settlement agreement
15 with Dorothy Markulis on the basis of the proposal negotiated and presented to City
16 Council on June 24, 2024.

18 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
19 from the Sanitary Sewer Fund, line item Other Operations.

21 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
22 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not
23 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
24 and confirmed.
