8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO
9 ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, WITH
10 OHM ADVISORS TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING
11 SERVICES FOR THE MUD BROOK TRAIL PHASE II, INCREASING
12 APPROPRIATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, the City followed the procedures set forth in Ohio Revised Code Sections 153.65 to 153.73
16 in selecting a professional design services firm to assist with the design of the Mud Brook Trail Phase II;
17 and

19 WHEREAS, after review of all the proposals submitted to the City, OHM Advisors was selected as the
20 most qualified for the project.
21

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit,
23 and State of Ohio, that:
24

25 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts,
26 according to law, with OHM Advisors to provide professional engineering services for the design of the Mud
27 Brook Trail Phase II.
28

29 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to appropriate funds to the Mudbrook-Mill
30 Pond Public Improvement Tax Increment Equivalent Fund line item Capital Outlay in the amount of
31 \$196,950 for professional engineering services for the design of the Mud Brook Trail Phase II, and the
32 Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same.
33

34 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent
35 herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which
36 have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

38 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating
39 to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of
40 this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the
41 public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
42

43 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
44 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and
45 the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected
46 or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by
47 the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


