AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING WITH KENMORE CONSTRUCTION FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF CITY STORM SEWER FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS AT 125 GRAHAM ROAD, AND INCREASING APPROPRIATIONS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City's 72-inch storm sewer at 125 Graham Road suffered damage due to the August  $8^{\rm th}$  storm; and

WHEREAS, Kenmore Construction was available to complete the emergency repairs expeditiously.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio that:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts without competitive bidding with Kenmore Construction, for the emergency replacement of 190 linear feet of 72-inch storm sewer at 125 Graham Road.

<u>Section 2.</u> The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the Storm Drainage Utility Fund, line-item Capital Outlay by \$196,300, and make payment for same.

<u>Section 3.</u> Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith, which have not previously been repealed, are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council and concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided that it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
