Temp. Ord. B-1

An ordinance authorizing the Mayor, as Director of Public Safety, to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Flock Group, Inc. for the use and maintenance of Flock Cameras for use by the city's safety forces, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-2

An ordinance implementing Sections 3735.65 through 3735.70 of the Ohio Revised Code, establishing and describing the boundaries of the Merriman Valley Schumacher Community Reinvestment Area in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.
