8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, WITH OSBORN ENGINEERING, FOR
11 PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE
12 RESURFACING OF BAILEY ROAD FROM FRONT STREET TO
13 GRAHAM ROAD, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
14

15 WHEREAS, the City followed the procedures set forth in Ohio Revised Code Sections 153.65 to
16 153.73 in selecting a professional design services firm to assist with the resurfacing of Bailey Road,
17 from Front Street to Graham Road; and

19 WHEREAS, after review of all the proposals submitted to the City, Osborn Engineering was
20 selected as the most qualified for the project.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
23 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

25 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
26 contracts, according to law, with Osborn Engineering for professional engineering services for the
27 resurfacing of Bailey Road, from Front Street to Graham Road.
28

29 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for the same from
30 the Capital Projects Fund, line item, Capital Outlay.

32 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
33 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
34 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
37 relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that
38 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action
39 were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent
40 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
41

42 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
43 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
44 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it received the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
45 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
46 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
47 period allowed by law.
