7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A
8 NOPEC ENERGIZED COMMUNITY GRANT AGREEMENT WITH
9 NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY COUNCIL, INC. FOR
10 ENERGY EFFICIENCY OR ENERGY INFRASTRUCTURE
11 PROJECTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public Energy
14 Council ("NOPEC") and is eligible for the NOPEC Energized Community Grant for 2025, as
15 provided for in the NOPEC grant program guidelines.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
18 of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
19

20 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a NOPEC Energized Community
21 Grant Agreement with NOPEC, Inc. for energy efficiency or energy infrastructure projects. The
22 Mayor, Director of Public Service, Director of Law, and other necessary City officials are
23 authorized to provide such other information and to execute such other documents, and do all
24 other actions as are necessary for and incidental to carrying out the requirements of this
25 ordinance and the terms of the Grant Agreement.

27 Section 2. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
28 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
29 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

31 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
32 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
33 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
34 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the
35 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
36

37 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
38 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
39 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of
40 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately
41 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the
42 earliest period allowed by law.
