1819 WHEREAS, Local Public Agencies, (LPAs) can apply for these monies and be selected
20 for funding by the Ohio Association of Regional Councils (OARC), who has been charged
21 with management of a statewide CMAQ program by ODOT; and
2223 WHEREAS, the Signal Improvement of Barney's Busy Corners is a transportation
24 activity eligible to receive federal CMAQ funding; and
2526 WHEREAS, if requested funds are granted, the City of Cuyahoga Falls shall be
27 responsible for at least twenty (20%) percent of the eligible costs; and
2829 WHEREAS, the Signal Improvement of Barney's Busy Corners is vital to the safe and
30 efficient travel of motorists from the cities of Cuyahoga Falls, Tallmadge and Akron; and
3132 WHEREAS, the Signal Improvement of Barney's Busy Corners is in need of improving
33 traffic flow and reduce delays to reduce congestion and improve efficiency, and reducing
34 crashes.
3536 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
37 County of Summit and State of Ohio:
3839 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for Federal Congestion
40 Mitigation/Air Quality (CMAQ) Funds programmed by the Akron Metropolitan Area
41 Transportation Study (AMATS) for the following Congestion Reduction Project:
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- 43 (1) The Improvement of Barney's Busy Corners, including relocation of
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- 44 roadways; estimated cost
- \$382,765.27
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46 Section 2. The City of Cuyahoga Falls acknowledges and understands the AMATS
47 2025 CMAQ Guidance and confirms to the best of its knowledge that the information
48 contained in the project application is accurate, that it intends to diligently pursue that
49 project, and that a local share is required to match federal funds.
5051 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
52 concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open
53 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
54 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
55 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
56 of the Codified Ordinances.
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59 Section 4. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
60 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
61 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
62 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
63 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
64 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


