67 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE INSTALLATION OF ABOVE  
10 GROUND FUEL STORAGE TANKS AND ASSOCIATED  
11 EQUIPMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.  
1213 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State  
14 of Ohio, that:15  
16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
17 contracts, according to law, for the installation of above ground fuel storage tanks and associated  
18 equipment.  
1920 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the  
21 Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.  
2223 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
24 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of  
25 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been  
26 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.  
2728 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and  
30 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal  
31 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including  
32 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
3334 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies and services are necessary for  
37 the daily functioning of the Municipal Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of  
38 two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force  
39 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in  
40 force at the earliest period allowed by law.
