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17 WHEREAS, the City Engineer has identified the need for and proposes the resurfacing
18 of Riverview Road, between Bath Road and Bolanz Road; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) is conducting
21 a competitive grant process under which Federal Surface Transportation Funds may be
22 made available to partially support construction costs for City-sponsored projects.
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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
25 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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27 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to apply for and accept
28 Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds programmed by the Akron
29 Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS), for the following improvement
30 project:
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32 Project Name: Riverview Road Resurfacing
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34 Description: From Bath Road and Bolanz Road, approximately 16,400-feet; resurface
35 roadway including grind and pave three-inches (3") of asphalt pavement, restripe
36 pavement markings and replace traffic loops.
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38 Section 2. This Council's authorization is granted with the following understandings:
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40 A. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of preliminary
41 engineering.

42 B. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost of those
43 features requested by the City which are not eligible for
44 Federal participation.

45 C. The Federal share will assume eighty percent (80%) of the construction
46 cost of the improvement not to exceed \$800,000.00. The City will be
47 responsible for the local share.

48 D. The City of Cuyahoga Falls is in receipt of and acknowledges the
49 applicability of the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" to this funding
50 request.

51 E. The Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make payment
52 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
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54 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
55 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
56 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
57 hereby ratified and confirmed.

58 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
59 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
60 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
61 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
62 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
63 of the Codified Ordinances.


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65 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
66 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
67 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
68 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
69 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
70 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


