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8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO APPLY FOR FEDERAL SURFACE

15 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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17 WHEREAS, the City Engineer has identified the need for and proposes the resurfacing of
18 Wyoga Lake Road, between East Steels Corners Road and Graham Road; and
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20 WHEREAS, the Akron Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS) is conducting a
21 competitive grant process under which Federal Surface Transportation Funds may be made
22 available to partially support construction costs for City-sponsored projects.
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24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
25 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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27 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is authorized to apply for and accept
28 Federal Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) funds programmed by the Akron
29 Metropolitan Area Transportation Study (AMATS), for the following improvement
30 project:
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32 Project Name: Wyoga Lake Road Resurfacing
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34 Description: From East Steels Corners Road to Graham Road, approximately 7,600-feet;
35 resurface roadway including grind and pave three-inches (3") of asphalt pavement, restripe
36 pavement markings and replace traffic loops.
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38 Section 2. This Council's authorization is granted with the following understandings:
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40 A. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the cost of preliminary
41 engineering.

42 B. The City will bear one hundred percent (100%) of the total cost of those
43 features requested by the City which are not eligible for
44 Federal participation.

45 C. The Federal share will assume eighty percent (80%) of the construction
46 cost of the improvement not to exceed \$800,000.00. The City will be
47 responsible for the local share.

48 D. The City of Cuyahoga Falls is in receipt of and acknowledges the
49 applicability of the AMATS "Funding Policy Guidelines" to this funding
50 request.


51 E. The Director of Finance be and hereby is authorized to make payment
52 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
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55 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
56 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
57 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
58 hereby ratified and confirmed.

59 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
60 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
61 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that
62 resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all
63 legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
64 Ordinances.


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66 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
67 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
68 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of
69 two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in
70 force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take
71 effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
