6 RESOLUTION NO. 10 - 2025

8 A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND URGING
9 PASSAGE OF ISSUE 52, THE CUYAHOGA FALLS CITY SCHOOL
10 DISTRICT RENEWAL LEVY, AT THE GENERAL ELECTION TO BE
11 HELD ON NOVEMBER 4, 2025, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has nine public schools in the City of
15 Cuyahoga Falls and the Village of Silver Lake, serving over 4,000 students; and

17 WHEREAS, a properly funded public school system is foundational to civic and economic
18 success; and

20 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls City School District has caused a proposed levy to be placed
21 on the November 4, 2025 ballot as Issue 52; and

23 WHEREAS, this levy is a renewal, not an increase, and stays at a rate not exceeding 9.97 mills
24 for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$191 for each \$100,000 of the county fiscal
25 officer's appraised value, for a continuing period of time, commencing in 2026 and first due in
26 2027; and

28 WHEREAS, this Administration and City Council express support for the proposed renewal
29 levy for the Cuyahoga Falls City School District, and urge the citizens of Cuyahoga Falls to vote
30 YES on Issue 52 at the November 4, 2025, General Election.

32 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
33 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

35 Section 1. The Council and Administration express their support for the Cuyahoga Falls City
36 School District renewal levy and urge the passage of Issue 52 at the November 4, 2025 General
37 Election.

39 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
40 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
41 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
42 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including,
43 to the extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

45 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
46 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
47 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
48 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
49 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
50 period allowed by law.
