New Ordinances & Resolutions

Temp. Ord. B-94

An ordinance approving text amendments to the Cuyahoga Falls Development Code adopting both a definition and regulations restricting the locations of vape shops, as more fully described and depicted herein, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-95

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with JCI Jones for the purchase of liquid chlorine to be utilized for water treatment throughout 2026, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-96

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purpose of upgrading the underground subtransmission cables leaving Valley Substation, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-97

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, after receiving public proposals, for the purpose of constructing a City owned 20 MW AC solar array located at the Hardy Road Landfill; authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a lease agreement with the City of Akron; and declaring an emergency.
