5 ORDINANCE NO. 84 - 2025

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH JCI JONES FOR THE
10 PURCHASE OF LIQUID CHLORINE TO BE UTILIZED FOR WATER
11 TREATMENT THROUGHOUT 2026, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.
13

14 WHEREAS, liquid chlorine is one of the four chemicals that the City uses to treat its raw
15 water before distribution into the water system; and
16

17 WHEREAS, Contract #9194—2025 Chemical Bid—Liquid Chlorine allowed the option to
18 extend the contract's bid price for an additional year; and
19

20 WHEREAS, JCI Jones has offered to extend the same unit price per ton for liquid chlorine
21 for 2026; and
22

23 WHEREAS, JCI Jones has been the lowest bidder of chlorine for at least the last 12 years.
24

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
26 of Summit and State of Ohio:
27

28 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
29 contracts, without competitive bidding, with JCI Jones for the purchase of liquid chlorine to be
30 utilized for water treatment throughout 2026.
31

32 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the
33 Water Fund, line item Other Operations.
34

35 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
36 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
37 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and
38 confirmed.

40 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
41 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
42 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
43 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the
44 extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
45

46 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
47 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
48 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
49 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
50 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
51 period allowed by law.


