WHEREAS, the Electric Department will be upgrading the subtransmission cables leaving the Valley Substation; and

WHEREAS, the Electric Department has solicited and received public bids for this work; and

WHEREAS, the Electric Department will be contracting out the construction of a new duct bank through Valley Vista Park with Premium Utility Contractor; and

WHEREAS, Premium Utility Contractor will install underground conduit encased in concrete as well as construct a protective raceway for the cables to enter the Valley Substation: and

WHEREAS, the Electric Department will pull in new cables through the completed duct bank and complete the cable terminations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

> Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purpose of upgrading the underground subtransmission cables leaving the Valley Substation.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Electric Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

56	for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the

59	upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force
