ORDINANCE NO. - 2025

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE HIGHPOINT ROAD SANITARY SEWER EXTENSION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the Highpoint Road Sewer Extension.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Sanitary Sewer Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

8 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL
9 FILE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

11 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and
12 maintained in the “Traffic Control File,” a document established and maintained by the
13 Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and

14
15 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic
16 Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.

17
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
19 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

20
21 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File
22 is hereby amended as follows:

24 Amending the Traffic Control File to eliminate all the school zones designated for
25 Cuyahoga Falls High School located at 2300 – 4th Street on 12/20/2025; including
26 4th Street, Thomas Court, Stow Avenue and 6th Street.

27
28 Amending the Traffic Control File to eliminate the school zone designated for
29 Roberts Middle School located at 3333 Charles Street on 12/20/2025.

30
31 Amending the Traffic Control File to eliminate all school zones designated for
32 Bolich Middle School located at 2630 – 13th Street on 12/20/2025; including 13th
33 Street, Portage Trail and Silver Lake Avenue.

34
35 Amending the Traffic Control File to add the school zone(s) in compliance with
36 ORC Section 4511.21 at the new Cuyahoga Falls 6-12 Campus located at 2630 –
37 13th Street; this will include 13th Street, Portage Trail and Silver Lake Avenue.

38
39 Amending the Traffic Control File to designate a school zone for Faith Islamic
40 Academy in compliance with ORC Section 4511.21 located at 152 E. Steels
41 Corners Road.

42
43 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new traffic signal at the State Road and
44 Seasons Road intersection.

45
46 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new traffic signal at the Wyoga Lake
47 Road and Seasons Road intersection.

48
49 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road northbound left turn
50 lane at Boulder Blvd.

52 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road northbound right turn
53 lane at Seasons Road.

Section 3. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5.
