7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL
10 REQUIREMENTS FOR CERTAIN SERVICES, MATERIALS,
11 SUPPLIES, AND EQUIPMENT FOR USE BY THE
12 ELECTRICAL DIVISION DURING 2026, AND DECLARING
13 AN EMERGENCY.14
15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
16 and State of Ohio, that:17
18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
19 or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the following services, materials,
20 supplies and equipment for use by the Electrical Division during 2026:21

25 Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
26 or contracts, without competitive bidding, with the vendors listed below, for the purchase
27 of the materials, supplies, and equipment for use by the Electrical Division during 2026:28

48 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
49 from the Electric Fund, line items Other Operations and Capital Outlay.50
51 Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
52 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
53 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
54 hereby ratified and confirmed.

56 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
57 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
58 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
59 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
60 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
61 of the Codified Ordinances.

62 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
63 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
64 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative
65 vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and
66 be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
67 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


