ORDINANCE NO. - 2026

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE MUD BROOK TRAIL PHASE 2, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the Mud Brook Trail Phase 2, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Mudbrook - Mill Pond Public Improvement Tax Increment Equivalent Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

ORDINANCE NO. - 2026

AN ORDINANCE APPROPRIATING COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT
BLOCK GRANT CARRYOVER FUNDS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026,
AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is the recipient of Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds through the Department of Housing and Urban Development; and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has available CDBG carryover funds, in the amount of \$464,795; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from calendar year 2025 to fund calendar year 2026 program operations; and

WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent information, that the aforementioned appropriations in the amount of \$464,795 are necessary and in the best interest of the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in the CDBG Fund, line item, Other Operations, by \$464,795 and make payments from the same.

Section 2. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary of the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
