13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and

16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
17 or contracts, according to law, for the Mud Brook Trail Phase 2, in the City of Cuyahoga
18 Falls.19
20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
21 from the Mudbrook - Mill Pond Public Improvement Tax Increment Equivalent Fund, line

26 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been

30 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open

8 BLOCK GRANT CARRYOVER FUNDS FOR CALENDAR YEAR 2026,

1011 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is the recipient of Community Development
12 Block Grant ("CDBG") funds through the Department of Housing and Urban
13 Development; and
1415 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls has available CDBG carryover funds, in the
16 amount of \$464,795; and
1718 WHEREAS, it is necessary to appropriate these carryover funds from calendar year
19 2025 to fund calendar year 2026 program operations; and
2021 WHEREAS, this Council finds and determines after reviewing all pertinent
22 information, that the aforementioned appropriations in the amount of \$464,795 are
23 necessary and in the best interest of the City of Cuyahoga Falls.
2425 NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
26 County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
2728 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to increase appropriations in
29 the CDBG Fund, line item, Other Operations, by \$464,795 and make payments from the
30 same.
3132 Section 2. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
