56 ORDINANCE NO. 110 – 2025
78 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC CONTROL
9 FILE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
1011 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and
12 maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the
13 Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and
1415 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic
16 Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.
1718 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
19 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
2021 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File
22 is hereby amended as follows:
2324 Amending the Traffic Control File to eliminate all the school zones designated for
25 Cuyahoga Falls High School located at 2300 – 4th Street on 12/20/2025; including
26 4th Street, Thomas Court, Stow Avenue and 6th Street.
2728 Amending the Traffic Control File to eliminate the school zone designated for
29 Roberts Middle School located at 3333 Charles Street on 12/20/2025.
3031 Amending the Traffic Control File to eliminate all school zones designated for
32 Bolich Middle School located at 2630 – 13th Street on 12/20/2025; including 13th
33 Street, Portage Trail and Silver Lake Avenue.
3435 Amending the Traffic Control File to add the school zone(s) in compliance with
36 ORC Section 4511.21 at the new Cuyahoga Falls 6-12 Campus located at 2630 –
37 13th Street; this will include 13th Street, Portage Trail and Silver Lake Avenue.
3839 Amending the Traffic Control File to designate a school zone for Faith Islamic
40 Academy in compliance with ORC Section 4511.21 located at 152 E. Steels
41 Corners Road.
4243 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new traffic signal at the State Road and
44 Seasons Road intersection.
4546 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new traffic signal at the Wyoga Lake
47 Road and Seasons Road intersection.
4849 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road northbound left turn
50 lane at Boulder Blvd.
5152 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road northbound right turn
53 lane at Seasons Road.

55 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road southbound left turn
56 lane at Seasons Road.

58 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road northbound left turn
59 lane at Hidden Lakes Lane.

60
61 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new State Road northbound left turn
62 lane at Pine Avenue.

64 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new Seasons Road westbound right
65 turn lane at State Road.

67 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new Seasons Road westbound left turn
68 lane at State Road.

69
70 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new Seasons Road eastbound right
71 turn lane at Wyoga Lake Road.

72
73 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new Seasons Road westbound left turn
74 lane at Wyoga Lake Road.

75
76 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new Wyoga Lake Road northbound left
77 turn lane at Seasons Road.

78
79 Amending the Traffic Control File to add a new Wyoga Lake Road northbound
80 right turn lane at Seasons Road.

81
82 Amending the Traffic Control File to remove the all-way stop at Wyoga Lake Road
83 and Seasons Road intersection.

84
85 Amending the Traffic Control File to remove the State Road southbound left turn
86 lane at Wyoga Lake Road.

87
88 Amending the Traffic Control File to add Cochran Road as a designated truck
89 route under Codified Ordinance Section 339.02.

90
91 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to note in the Traffic Control File
92 the proper legends.

93
94 Section 3. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to cause the installation
95 or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

96
97 Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
98 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions
99 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
100 been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

101
102 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
103 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
104 Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that
105 resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with
106 all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
107 Ordinances.

110 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
111 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
112 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative
113 vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and
114 be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
115 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
