8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS  
10 WITH MILSOFT UTILITY SOLUTIONS FOR THE PURPOSE  
11 OF INSTALLING AND MAINTAINING AN OUTAGE  
12 MANAGEMENT SYSTEM FOR THE CUYAHOGA FALLS  
13 ELECTRIC SYSTEM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.14  
15 WHEREAS, the Electric Department must purchase software to improve the  
16 operational management of the electric distribution system in the City; and17  
18 WHEREAS, the Electric Department has solicited and received RFQs for this project  
19 and it was determined that Milsoft Utility Solutions is the best fit for the system because  
20 it integrates with the City's Aclara One meters; and21  
22 WHEREAS, this software will allow the Electric Department to more quickly locate the  
23 source of an outage and also sent electronic messages to residents informing and  
24 updating them of outage information; and25  
26 WHEREAS, Milsoft Utility Solutions will provide and train staff to utilize this software.27  
28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
29 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:30  
31 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract  
32 or contracts with Milsoft Utility Solutions for the purpose of installing and maintaining  
33 an outage management system for the Cuyahoga Falls Electric System.34  
35 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same  
36 from the Electric Fund, line item Other Operations.37  
38 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
39 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
40 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are  
41 hereby ratified and confirmed.42  
43 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
44 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this  
45 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that  
46 resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with  
47 all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.48  
49 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
50 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
51 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the  
52 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take  
53 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise  
54 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
