


9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
10 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
11 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, WITH POWER LINE
12 SUPPLY COMPANY, FOR THE PURCHASE OF MAJOR
13 EQUIPMENT FOR THE CAPACITOR BANKS AT VALLEY
14 SUBSTATION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
1516 WHEREAS, the Valley Sub sub-transmission system gets heavily loaded in the summer
17 and it is desirable to add equipment that will reduce current flow.
1819 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
20 County of Summit and State of Ohio:21
22 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
23 or contracts, according to law, with Power Line Supply Company, for the purchase of
24 major equipment for the capacitor banks at Valley Substation.
2526 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
27 from the Electric Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
2829 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
30 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
31 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
32 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
3334 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
35 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
36 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
37 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
38 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
39 of the Codified Ordinances.
4041 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
42 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
43 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
44 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
45 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
46 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
