ORDINANCE NO - 2026

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THE CITY'S ANNUAL REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN SERVICES, MATERIALS AND SUPPLIES FOR USE BY THE WATER, SEWER, AND STORM WATER DIVISIONS DURING 2026, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of the City's requirements for the following services, materials and supplies for use by the Water, Sewer, and Storm Water Divisions during 2026:

Water Treatment Chemicals
Utility Patch Program
Meters and Related Materials
Waterline and Sewer Line Supplies
Waterline and Sewer Line CCTV Work

Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with the vendors listed below, for the purchase of the materials, supplies, and equipment for use by the Water, Sewer, and Storm Water Divisions during 2026:

Collins Excavating & Construction
Core & Main LP
East Jordon Iron Works
Ferguson Enterprises Inc
KJ Excavation
S & S Excavating Inc.
Superior Drain

Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same from the Water Fund, Sewage and Disposal Fund, and Storm Water Fund, line items Other Operations and Capital Outlay.

Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

55 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
56 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
57 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
58 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
59 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
60 of the Codified Ordinances.

62 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
63 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
64 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative
65 vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and
66 be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
67 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
