7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE ANNUAL
10 RESURFACING AND/OR REPAIR OF VARIOUS STREETS
11 AS DESCRIBED IN EXHIBIT 'A' ATTACHED HERETO, IN
12 THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS AND AUTHORIZING THE
13 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A
14 CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS FOR PAVEMENT
15 PRESERVATION ON VARIOUS STREETS WITHIN THE
16 CITY, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

18 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
19 State of Ohio:

21 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
22 or contracts, according to law, for the resurfacing and/or repair of various streets as
23 described in Exhibit 'A' attached hereto, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

25 Section 2. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
26 or contracts, according to law, for pavement preservation on various streets within the
27 City.

28
29 Section 3. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
30 payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay, and from the
31 Storm Drainage Utility Fund, line item Other Operations.



33 Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
34 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
35 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
36 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

38 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
39 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
40 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
41 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
42 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
43 of the Codified Ordinances.

45 Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
46 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
47 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
48 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
49 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
50 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
