9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND
10 RECREATION BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
11 CONTRACTS, WITHOUT COMPETITIVE BIDDING, WITH
12 SITE TECHNOLOGY INC., FOR REPAIRS TO THE
13 CUYAHOGA FALLS HIGH SCHOOL TENNIS COURTS, AND
14 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16 WHEREAS, Site Technology Inc. is the sole source purveyor of the Novacrylic
17 Combination Color Surface System which is a proprietary application and Site Technology
18 Inc. is the only authorized surface applicator in the area; and

19
20 WHEREAS, the tennis courts will be used by the Cuyahoga Falls boys and girls tennis
21 teams and, at all other times, available to the public.

22
23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
24 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

26 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a
27 contract or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Site Technology Inc., for repairs
28 to the Cuyahoga Falls High School tennis courts.

29
30 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
31 from the Recreation Levy Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

32
33 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
34 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
35 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
36 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

37
38 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
39 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this
40 Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in
41 those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
42 requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

43
44 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
45 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
46 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
47 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
48 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
49 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
