8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER  
9 INTO A NOPEC ENERGIZED COMMUNITY GRANT  
10 AGREEMENT WITH NORTHEAST OHIO PUBLIC ENERGY  
11 COUNCIL, INC., FOR ENERGY EFFICIENCY OR ENERGY  
12 INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECTS, AND DECLARING AN  
13 EMERGENCY.14 WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls is a member of the Northeast Ohio Public  
15 Energy Council ("NOPEC") and is eligible for the NOPEC Energized Community Grant for  
16 2026, as provided for in the NOPEC grant program guidelines.17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
18 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:19  
20 Section 1. The Mayor is hereby authorized to enter into a NOPEC Energized  
21 Community Grant Agreement with Northeast Ohio Public Energy Council, Inc. for energy  
22 efficiency or energy infrastructure projects. The Mayor, Director of Public Service,  
23 Director of Law, and other necessary City officials are authorized to provide such other  
24 information and to execute such other documents, and do all other actions as are  
25 necessary for and incidental to carrying out the requirements of this ordinance and the  
26 terms of the Grant Agreement.27  
28 Section 2. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
29 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
30 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are  
31 hereby ratified and confirmed.32  
33 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
34 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
35 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
36 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in  
37 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107  
38 of the Codified Ordinances.39  
40 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
41 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
42 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the  
43 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take  
44 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise  
45 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.46
