8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
9 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
10 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR REPLACING
11 NON-COPPER WATER SERVICE LINES, AND DECLARING
12 AN EMERGENCY.

15 WHEREAS, Ordinance ____-2026 authorized the Mayor to apply for, accept, and enter
16 into a Water Supply Revolving Loan Account Agreement with the Ohio Environmental
17 Protection Agency on behalf of the City for replacing non-copper water service lines; and
18

19 WHEREAS, the City seeks to complete the Lead Service Line Replacement project and
20 use Water Supply Revolving Loan Account funds to fund the project.
21

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
23 County of Summit and State of Ohio:
24

25 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
26 or contracts, according to law, for replacing non-copper water service lines.
27

28 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
29 from the Water Fund, line item Other Operations.
30

31 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
32 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
33 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
34 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

36 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
37 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
38 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
39 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in
40 compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107
41 of the Codified Ordinances.
42

43 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
44 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
45 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, provided it receives the affirmative
46 vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and
47 be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall
48 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
