6 RESOLUTION NO. 1 - 2026

8 A RESOLUTION EXPRESSING SUPPORT FOR AND URGING
9 PASSAGE OF ISSUE 5, THE CUYAHOGA FALLS LIBRARY LEVY,
10 AT THE PRIMARY ELECTION TO BE HELD ON MAY 5, 2026, AND
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls Library is an independent public library serving the residents
14 of Cuyahoga Falls and Silver Lake; and

15
16 WHEREAS, the levy currently funding the Cuyahoga Falls Library expires this year; and

17
18 WHEREAS, the Cuyahoga Falls Library is requesting a levy to be placed on the May 5, 2026
19 ballot as Issue 5; and

21 WHEREAS, the county fiscal officer estimates that the levy will collect \$2,459,557 annually,
22 at a rate not exceeding 2.2 mills for each \$1 of taxable value, which amounts to \$77 for each
23 \$100,000 of the county fiscal officer's appraised value, for 5 years, commencing in 2026 and first
24 due in calendar year 2027.

26 WHEREAS, this Administration expresses support for the proposed levy for the Cuyahoga
27 Falls Library, and urges the citizens of Cuyahoga Falls to vote YES on Issue 5 at the May 5, 2026
28 Primary Election.

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
31 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

33 Section 1. The Administration expresses their support for the Cuyahoga Falls Library levy
34 and urges the passage of Issue 5 at the May 5, 2026 Primary Election.

36 Section 2. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
37 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
38 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
39 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including,
40 to the extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

41
42 Section 3. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
43 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
44 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
45 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
46 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
47 period allowed by law.
