5 ORDINANCE NO. 25 - 2026

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF  
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR  
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE  
10 REPLACEMENT OF THE 8" WATER MAIN IN BAILEY  
11 ROAD, FROM MYRTLE AVENUE TO MCSHANE DRIVE,  
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13  
14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and  
15 State of Ohio, that:

16  
17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract  
18 or contracts, according to law, for the replacement of the 8" water main in Bailey Road,  
19 from Myrtle Avenue to McShane Drive.

21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment  
22 for same from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

24 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
25 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
26 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are  
27 hereby ratified and confirmed.

29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning  
30 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this  
31 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that  
32 resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with  
33 all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified  
34 Ordinances.

35  
36 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
37 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
38 City of Cuyahoga Falls, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
39 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately  
40 upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force  
41 at the earliest period allowed by law.
