8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURPOSE OF
11 PURCHASING A MEGGER RELAY TEST SET, AND
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
13

14 WHEREAS, the Electric Department will be testing relays at City Substations; and

15
16 WHEREAS, the purchase by contract of the equipment, services, materials or
17 supplies identified herein is through participation in a contract between the vendor and
18 OhioBuys, a cooperative purchasing group, and is thus exempt from competitive bidding
19 requirements pursuant to Ohio Revised Code §125.04.
20

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
22 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
23

24 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
25 or contracts, according to law, for the purpose of purchasing a Megger Relay Test Set.
26

27 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to make payment for same
28 from the Electric Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
29

30 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
31 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
32 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are
33 hereby ratified and confirmed.
34

35 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
36 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
37 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that
38 resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with
39 all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.


41 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
42 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
43 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the
44 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
45 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise
46 it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
