9 FOR, ACCEPT, AND ENTER INTO A COOPERATIVE
10 AGREEMENT WITH THE OHIO WATER DEVELOPMENT
11 AUTHORITY FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF THE 8" WATER
12 MAIN IN BAILEY ROAD, FROM MYRTLE AVENUE TO
13 MCSHANE DRIVE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
14

15 WHEREAS, the City desires to obtain a loan from the Ohio Water Development
16 Authority ("OWDA") for the Bailey Road water line improvements with the replacement of
17 the 8" water main in Bailey Road from Myrtle Avenue to McShane Drive; and
18

19 WHEREAS, the City intends to apply for an OWDA Fresh Water Loan Program loan
20 for the construction costs of the Bailey Road water line improvements; and
21

22 WHEREAS, the OWDA requires a government authority to pass legislation for the
23 application of a loan and the execution of an agreement, as well as designating a
24 repayment source.
25

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
27 County of Summit, State of Ohio, that:
28

29 Section 1. This Council hereby authorizes the Mayor to apply for, accept, and enter
30 into a Cooperative Agreement with the OWDA for the replacement of the 8" water main in
31 Bailey Road, from Myrtle Avenue to McShane Drive.
32

33 Section 2. The Mayor, Director of Public Service, Director of Finance, Director of Law,
34 any other public official, individually or collectively as may be appropriate, are authorized
35 to prepare and execute such other documents, including contracts, and do all other
36 things as necessary or incidental to carrying out the intent and/or requirements of the
37 Cooperative Agreement and this ordinance.
38

39 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
40 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
41 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and any of its
42 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in
43 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
44

45 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
46 for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience, and
47 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and the inhabitants thereof, and provided that it

15 require the relocation of the existing 2MG clearwell noted during the General Plan review;
16 and

18 WHEREAS, additional surveying was required to explore additional access to the site
19 once the main driveway closes to the public; and
20

21 WHEREAS, a corrosion control evaluation was required by Ohio EPA during the
22 General Plan review.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,

14 bidding, entered into Contract No. with Perrin Asphalt Company, for the annual
15 resurfacing and/or repair of various streets; and

18 bid, the City intends to allocate the savings toward additional repairs on various streets.

19

24 modification of Contract No. with Perrin Asphalt Company for the annual resurfacing

15 WHEREAS, as authorized by Ordinance 52-2024, the South Front Streetscape
16 project is currently under construction, which requires new underground
17 stormwater piping and infrastructure to be installed; and
18

19 WHEREAS, during the excavation for this stormwater infrastructure at the
20 locations of 1816 Front Street and 1914 Front Street, multiple previously
21 unknown underground storage tanks were discovered and need to be removed in
22 a timely manner to allow for the South Front construction to progress on schedule;
23 and
24

25 WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 735.051 authorizes this Council to
26 waive formal competitive bidding and advertising for contracts where there is a
27 real and present emergency arising in connection with the operation and
28 maintenance of a municipally-owned facility; and
29

30 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
31 County of Summit and State of Ohio:
32

33 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
34 or contracts without competitive bidding with Patriot Engineering and Environmental,
35 Inc. for the emergency removal of underground storage tanks on Front Street in the City
36 of Cuyahoga Falls.
37

38 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
39 payment for same from the Capital Project Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
40

41 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
42 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
43 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been

9 FILE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

10
11 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established and
12 maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and maintained by the
13 Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified Ordinances; and
14

15 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the Traffic
16 Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.
17

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
19 County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

21 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic Control File
22 is hereby amended as follows:

24 Amending the Traffic Control File to restrict parking on Reserve Drive from E.
25 Bath Road to Heritage Drive on the even side.

27 Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to note in the Traffic Control File
28 the proper legends.

30 Section 3. The Mayor or his designee is hereby authorized to cause the installation
31 or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.
