### **Group Leader Volunteer Information**

Safety Town is a nonprofit educational program geared toward students entering kindergarten residing in Cuyahoga Falls. The curriculum involves a variety of safety topics and issues.

Safety Town will be held at the Cuyahoga Falls Natatorium from June 1-5 and June 8-12, 2026.

**Week I** Sessions for campers are: from 9:00am -11:00am or 12:00pm - 2:00pm.

You will be required to work from Monday - Friday 8:30am - 2:30 pm.

**Week II** Session for campers are: from 9:00am -11:00am.

You will be required to work from Monday - Friday 8:30am – 11:30am.

You may choose to work one week or both weeks, **but you must work every day of the week(s) you choose**. You will also be **required** to attend a brief training meeting prior to Safety Town. Being a group leader at Safety Town is a very important responsibility. The children need to establish a good relationship with you to feel safe and secure. We need to know that we can depend on you to make a commitment to work through the entire week(s) at Safety Town.

As a group leader, you and another volunteer will be assigned to a group of six to eight children. Each day, you will meet with your group at the assigned table to review the previous day's information, color pages in the Safety Town Activity Book, and/or practice the safety songs. Next, you will follow a schedule for the day which may include listening to a speaker such as a fire fighter, police officer; watching a video; touring the Natatorium Aquatic Center with a lifeguard; riding a school bus; or actively participate with the children in the fire safety house.

If you enjoy working with young children (5-6 years old) and would like to be involved in Safety Town, please complete the attached application and attachments, and return by mail to the Cuyahoga Falls Fire Department, 1924 Front Street, Cuyahoga Falls, OH 44221, by fax at 330-971-8409 or email to [fire@cityofcf.com](mailto:fire@cityofcf.com). We will be looking for 15-18 confident, qualified, caring leaders. We will consider the applications and contact students whom we determine to be the best candidates. There will be a **mandatory orientation meeting for all volunteers** on **Wednesday, May 13, 2026 from 7:00 – 8:00 pm**, at CFFD Station 5 located @ 3497 Wyoga Lake Rd Cuyahoga Falls OH 44224. You will receive an email at the email address providing instructions for the orientation. You will receive a Safety Town volunteer T-Shirt, lunch each week and community service hours for volunteering.
