

Home Health & Safety Tips

- Smoke detectors should be located on every level of your home and inside each bedroom. Replace batteries twice a year. Some newer smoke detector models have 10-year batteries.
- Carbon monoxide (CO) detectors are lifesavers, too! CO alarms will notify inhabitants if a defective heater burning natural gas, oil, propane, wood or kerosene is emitting this odorless gas into your home.
- Have your home tested for radon. Radon is a radioactive gas that exists naturally in soil and can enter your home through basement cracks, joints and gaps. Concentrated levels of radon can lead to serious health issues.
- Keep the area around your heating system clear and make sure your heating system is properly vented to the outside to prevent CO buildup indoors. Never store combustibles near a furnace.

The Cuyahoga Falls Water Department staff ensures that water distribution, sanitary sewer and storm sewer collection systems are properly maintained every day. Emergencies within these systems are addressed immediately, 24/7. Cuyahoga Falls Water Treatment Plant operators are all EPA certified in water supply systems and maintain water plant operations around the clock.

■ Stormwater Management

Through an inspection, the Stormwater Management division of the Water Department can assist with identifying and eliminating inflow and infiltration of clean water into the sanitary sewer system which can cause basement backups during heavy rain events.

■ Hydrant Flushing

Cuyahoga Falls holds the excellent Class III fire insurance rating as issued by the Insurance Services Office of Ohio. Fire hydrants throughout the community are flushed annually during the months of June and July to ensure that they operate safely and efficiently.


Clear Streets for Clean Streets Winter Tips to Help Keep Our Routes Safe
