



City of Cuyahoga Falls Recycle Guide

ACCEPTABLE MATERIALS FOR RECYCLING

Recycling is as simple as A, B, C!

(A) REMOVE ALL CAPS AND LIDS AND DISCARD

(B) LIGHTLY RINSE CONTAINERS

(C) PLACE ALL RECYCLABLE MATERIALS LOOSE

INTO YOUR CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS CURBSIDE

RECYCLING CART – Do Not Bag! (Recyclable materials placed

outside the Recycle Cart will be picked up as trash and will result in an additional charge).

METAL: Beverage, food, and pet food cans (includes metal, bimetal, tin, and aluminum).

PAPER: Newspaper, magazines, junk mail, telephone books, catalogs, cardboard, paperboard (cereal boxes, beverage and food boxes/cartons, milk cartons, and juice boxes). Cardboard boxes must be broken down and placed **INSIDE** Recycle Cart. Shredded paper is not recyclable through municipal recycle collections. Contact Summit ReWorks at 330-374-0383 for information on local paper recycling companies who accept shredded paper.

PLASTICS: Bottles and jugs- including food, beverage, laundry detergent, dish soap and bathing product bottles, etc. (No plastic bags or plastic wrap).

UNACCEPTABLE MATERIALS

The City of Cuyahoga Falls Recycling Program Does NOT Accept:

- Paint cans, anti-freeze, motor oil, and pesticide/herbicide containers (call Summit ReWorks for information at 330-374-0383).
- Plastic Bags – plastic bags are collected for recycling at local retail and grocery stores.
- Styrofoam, toys, plastic utensils, and tires.
- Light bulbs, mirrors, and windows.
- Metal or plastic hangers, and metal doors.
- Medical wastes of any kind including hypodermic needles, etc.

PLEASE USE RECYCLE CARTS APPROPRIATELY
Recycle Carts are for Acceptable Recyclables **ONLY**
DO NOT place garbage, non-recyclable wastes or yard wastes into Recycle Cart!
