7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF
8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A MODIFICATION
9 OF CONTRACT NO. 6502 WITH LIBERTA
10 CONSTRUCTION CO., INC. dba CIOFFI
11 CONSTRUCTION, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 WHEREAS, under the authority of Ordinance 115-2009 the City, after
14 competitive bidding, entered into Contract No. 6502 with Liberta Construction Co.,
15 Inc. dba Cioffi Construction, for the purposes of replacement of the Storm and
16 Sanitary Sewers on 11th, 12th, 13th Streets, and Jefferson, Phelps and Leavitt
17 Avenues, near Oak Park; and

19 WHEREAS, it is necessary to adjust the unit quantities of labor and material in
20 the contract beyond what was originally estimated, and to perform additional work,
21 in order to meet the needs of the City in executing the replacement of the Storm
22 and Sanitary Sewers on 11th, 12th, 13th Streets, and Jefferson, Phelps and Leavitt
23 Avenue, near Oak Park, which will increase the estimated total contract price by an
24 amount not exceeding \$55,033.00.

26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga
27 Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:
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29 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a
30 modification of the Contract No. 6502 with Liberta Construction Co., Inc. dba Cioffi
31 Construction, increasing the unit quantities of labor and material, and authorizing
32 additional work, as necessary in the opinion of the Director of Public Service, but
33 not to exceed an amount \$55,033.00 over the original estimated contract price.

35 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to pay
36 invoices for work based upon the Contract as modified, in an amount not to exceed
37 \$55,033.00, over the original estimated contract price, from the Sanitary Sewer
38 Fund and the Storm Drainage Utility Fund, Line Item Capital Outlay.

40 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
41 resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any
42 ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not
43 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby
44 ratified and confirmed.
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46 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
47 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
48 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
49 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public,
50 in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the extent applicable,
51 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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
