7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF FINANCE
8 TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH THE CITY OF CLEVELAND,
9 OHIO TO ESTABLISH MEMBERSHIP IN THE CENTRAL
10 COLLECTION AGENCY AND FOR THE PURCHASE OF CERTAIN
11 INCOME TAX COLLECTIONS SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN
12 EMERGENCY.

14 WHEREAS, to the extent the contract referred to herein involves the purchase of services,
15 such purchase is exempt from competitive bidding requirements pursuant to the authority of
16 Ohio Revised Code §735.053,

17
18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County
19 of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

20
21 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into an agreement with the
22 City of Cleveland, Ohio to establish membership of the City of Cuyahoga Falls in the Central Col-
23 lection Agency, and to obtain certain income tax collections services, substantially in the form of
24 agreement placed on file with the Clerk of Council in Council File No. _____.

25
26 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
27 same from the Income Tax Fund, line item Other Operations.

28
29 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordi-
31 nances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
32 are hereby ratified and confirmed.

33
34 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
35 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
36 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
37 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
38 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

39
40 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
42 Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the
43 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
44 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
45 period allowed by law.
