Notice is hereby given that a Special Meeting of City Council will be held on Tuesday, February 22, 2011 at 6:29 p.m. for the following purposes.


1. To introduce and assign to the Public Improvements Committee and vote on the following ordinance.

7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC  
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,  
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR IMPROVEMENTS TO THE PORTAGE  
10 TRAIL AND NORTHAMPTON ROAD INTERSECTION, AND  
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
14 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

15  
16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or  
17 contracts, according to law, for improvements to the Portage Trail and Northampton Road  
18 intersection.

19  
20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same  
21 from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

22  
23 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
24 inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not  
25 inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and  
26 confirmed.

27  
28 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that  
30 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were  
31 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Chapter 107 of  
32 the Codified Ordinances.

33  
34 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls  
36 and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members  
37 elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and  
38 approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by  
39 law.
