New Ordinances & Resolutions

Temp. Ord. B-6 (Planning & Zoning)

An ordinance approving the application of Daniel Michael Lynch, Trustee, as owner of certain real property located at 643/653 West Steels Corners Road (Parcel Nos. 35-00045, 35-05391 and 35-05392), to place said property into an agricultural district pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 929, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-7 (Finance)

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the purchase of mail processing equipment and associated software for use in the Utility Billing Department, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-8 (Public Improvements)

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for concrete and masonry repairs to the city-owned parking garages located at 2035 Old Town Loop (the "Blue" parking deck), 2052 Front Street (the "Red" parking deck), and 2318 Second Street (the "Green" parking deck) and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-1

An ordinance levying special assessments for the repair or replacement of sidewalks and drive approaches in the Sidewalk and Drive Approach Repair and Replacement District, for the year 2012, and declaring an emergency.

Public & Industrial Improvements:

Temp. Ord. B-3

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the design-build services necessary to conduct the riparian restoration of Kelsey Creek, and for associated stream bank restoration, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Ord. B-4

An ordinance authorizing the Director of Public Service to enter into a contract or contracts, according to law, for the replacement or adjustment of concrete sidewalks, drive approaches and curbs at various locations in the City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring an emergency.

Temp. Res. B-5

A resolution creating for the year 2013 a Sidewalk and Drive Approach Repair or Replacement District containing such streets, alleys, or public roadways within the corporate limits of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, declaring the necessity of repairing or replacing the sidewalks and drive approaches abutting on such streets, alleys or public roadways within said corporate limits and providing the method for levying special assessments, and declaring an emergency.
