8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPAIR, RESURFACING
11 AND/OR RECONSTRUCTION OF VARIOUS STREETS IN
12 THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA FALLS AND DECLARING AN
13 EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and
16 State of Ohio, that:

17
18 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
19 contracts, according to law, to execute the annual street resurfacing program, including the
20 repair, resurfacing and/or reconstruction of various streets as described in Exhibit 'A'
21 attached hereto, in the City of Cuyahoga Falls.

22
23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment
24 for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

25
26 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
27 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
28 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
29 and confirmed.

30
31 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning
32 and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this
33 Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted
34 in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal
35 requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

36
37 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for
38 the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of
39 Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary
40 to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the
41 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
42 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it
43 shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF AN 8"
10 WATER MAIN IN MAITLAND AVENUE BETWEEN STATE ROAD
11 AND 26TH STREET, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
14 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

16 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
17 contracts, according to law, for construction of a new 8" water main in Maitland Avenue between
18 State Road and 26th Street.

19
20 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
21 from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

22
23 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
24 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
25 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

27 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
