AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS WITH AN ENGINEERING FIRM OR FIRMS TO PROVIDE PROFESSIONAL ENGINEERING SERVICES IMPROVEMENTS TO HOWE AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or contracts with an engineering firm or firms to provide professional engineering services for the improvements to Howe Avenue.

Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund.

Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith be and the same are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason that it is immediately necessary to permit timely and appropriate development of this property, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT TO FILE A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State of Ohio, through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, administers financial assistance for public recreation purposes through the federal Land and Water Conservation Fund Program and/or State of Ohio NatureWorks Program, and

WHEREAS, the City of Cuyahoga Falls desires financial assistance under the NatureWorks Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of Ohio that:

Section 1. The Director of Community Development is hereby authorized to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required in said application to obtain a grant for the acquisition of public outdoor recreation areas through the NatureWorks Program.

Section 2. The City does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the NatureWorks Program.

Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4.
