7 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
8 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
9 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE PURCHASE OF ANNUAL
10 REQUIREMENTS OF CERTAIN MATERIALS, SUPPLIES AND
11 SERVICES FOR USE BY THE GARAGE DIVISION DURING 2014,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State
15 of Ohio, that:

17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the purchase of certain materials, supplies and services for use by
19 the Garage Division during 2014:

22 Tires

26 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
27 same from the Garage Fund, line item Other Operations.

29 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
30 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of
31 ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been
32 repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

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34 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
35 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and
36 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
37 action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including
38 Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

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40 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
41 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
42 Falls and the inhabitants thereof for the reason that the supplies are necessary for the daily
43 functioning of the Municipal Garage, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of
44 the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon
45 its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
46 period allowed by law.

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7 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 129 OF
8 PART ONE, TITLE FIVE OF THE CODIFIED
9 ORDINANCES, RELATING TO THE POLICE
10 DEPARTMENT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

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12 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
13 Summit, and State of Ohio, that:

14
15 Section 1. Chapter 129 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of
16 Cuyahoga Falls is hereby amended to enact Sections 129.07 to read as follows:

17
18 129.07 PARKING ENFORCEMENT UNIT.

19
20 (a) There is hereby created within the Department of Public Safety of the
21 City a Parking Enforcement Unit within the Police Department of the City with
22 members appointed by the Mayor as Director of Public Safety or his designated
23 representative.

24
25 (b) The Parking Enforcement Officers shall serve as long as the Director
26 of Public Safety may direct or until their resignation submitted by such officer
27 shall be accepted by the Director of Public Safety.

28
29 (c) The Chief of Police shall be the executive head of the Parking
30 Enforcement Unit, and shall make all recommendations for appointments and
31 removals of Parking Enforcement Officers, subject to any general rules
32 prescribed by the Legislative Authority by ordinance, and shall provide for the
33 rules for the organization, training, administration, control and conduct of the
34 Parking Enforcement Unit.

35
36 (d) The Police Chief shall be the commander of the Parking Enforcement
37 Unit.

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39 (e) The authority of the Parking Enforcement Officers shall be limited to
40 the enforcement of ordinances governing parking in handicap parking locations
41 and fire lanes and other parking ordinances specified in these Codified
42 Ordinances.

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44 (f) Parking Enforcement Officers shall have no other powers.

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46 (g) The training that the Parking Enforcement Officers shall receive shall
47 include instruction in general administrative rules and procedures governing
48 the Parking Enforcement Unit, the role of the judicial system as it relates to
49 parking regulation and enforcement, proper techniques and methods relating to
50 the enforcement of parking ordinances, human interaction skills, and first aid.

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(h) The Director of Public Safety is authorized to prescribe the type of uniform or part thereof to be worn by the Parking Enforcement Officers.

(i) The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized and directed to promulgate such executive orders, rules and regulations as, in his discretion, are either necessary or desirable in the administration of such Parking Enforcement Unit.

Section 2. Existing Section 923.10 of the Codified Ordinances, as enacted by Ord. No. 60-1996, passed April 22, 1996, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
