6  
7 AN ORDINANCE LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS FOR  
8 THE REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT OF SIDEWALKS AND  
9 DRIVE APPROACHES IN THE SIDEWALK AND DRIVE  
10 APPROACH REPAIR AND REPLACEMENT DISTRICT, FOR  
11 THE YEAR 2014, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12  
13 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 1-2014, adopted by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga  
14 Falls on January 13, 2014, created the Sidewalk and Drive Approach Repair and  
15 Replacement District for the year 2014, and determined the necessity of adjusting or  
16 replacing certain sidewalks and drive approaches within the district; and

17  
18 WHEREAS, such sidewalks and drive approaches within the district have been  
19 repaired or replaced;

20  
21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,  
22 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

23  
24 Section 1. The portion of the total cost and expense of repairing or replacing  
25 sidewalks and driveway approaches located within the Sidewalk and Drive Approach  
26 Repair and Replacement District for the year 2014 to be paid for by special assessments  
27 is hereby established at the rate of \$12.00 per linear foot for replacement and \$5.00 per  
28 square foot for driveway approaches. That portion of the total cost of the improvement  
29 to be paid for by special assessments is hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and  
30 lands provided for in the schedule of special assessments now on file with the Clerk of  
31 Council, which special assessments are in proportion to the special benefits and are not  
32 in excess of any statutory limitation and which are hereby adopted and confirmed.

33  
34 Section 2. The assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in  
35 cash within thirty (30) days from the levy thereof in the office of the Finance Director  
36 with the further provision that all assessments thereof remaining unpaid at the  
37 expiration of said thirty days shall be certified by the Clerk of Council to the County  
38 Fiscal Officer to be placed on the tax duplicate and collected in two (2) semi-annual  
39 installments.

40  
41 Section 3. A certified copy of this ordinance shall be provided to the County Fiscal  
42 Officer by the Clerk of Council within twenty (20) days after its passage.

43  
44 Section 4. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and  
45 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and  
46 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are  
47 hereby ratified and confirmed.

48  
49 Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council  
50 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open  
51 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its  
52 Committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public in  
53 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified  
54 Ordinances.

56        Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary  
57 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the  
58 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the  
59 affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall  
60 take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

9 A RESOLUTION CREATING FOR THE YEAR 2015 A SIDEWALK AND  
10 DRIVE APPROACH REPAIR OR REPLACEMENT DISTRICT  
11 CONTAINING SUCH STREETS, ALLEYS, OR PUBLIC ROADWAYS  
12 WITHIN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE CITY OF CUYAHOGA  
13 FALLS, DECLARING THE NECESSITY OF REPAIRING OR  
14 REPLACING THE SIDEWALKS AND DRIVE APPROACHES  
15 ABUTTING ON SUCH STREETS, ALLEYS OR PUBLIC ROADWAYS  
16 WITHIN SAID CORPORATE LIMITS AND PROVIDING THE METHOD  
17 FOR LEVYING SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS, AND DECLARING AN  
18 EMERGENCY.

19  
20 WHEREAS, it is the opinion of this Council that certain sidewalks and drive approaches  
21 abutting on the streets, alleys or public roadways within the City of Cuyahoga Falls are in  
22 disrepair.

23  
24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of  
25 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

26  
27 Section 1. A Sidewalk and Drive Approach Repair or Replacement District is hereby created for  
28 the year 2015 containing those streets, alleys or public roadways within the corporate limits of the  
29 City of Cuyahoga Falls, and declaring the necessity of repairing or replacing the sidewalks and  
30 drive approaches abutting on such streets, alleys or public roadways, and to provide the method  
31 for levying assessments and the right to object to or appeal said assessment.

32  
33 Section 2. It is hereby declared that the repair or replacement of sidewalks and drive  
34 approaches abutting on necessary streets, alleys and public roadways within the Sidewalk and  
35 Drive Approach Repair or Replacement District is necessary and will be of general benefit within  
36 the City and of special benefit to property owners abutting said sidewalks and drive approaches.

37  
38 Section 3. Property abutting the necessary streets, alleys and public roadways receiving  
39 sidewalk repair or replacement within the District may be assessed by the lineal foot of abutting  
40 sidewalk at the rate of one-half of the total cost of installing or adjusting a linear foot of sidewalk,  
41 with the remainder of such cost to be paid by the City. Property abutting the necessary streets,  
42 alleys and public roadways receiving drive approach repair or replacement within the District may  
43 be assessed by the square foot of drive approach at the rate of one-half of the total cost of installing  
44 or adjusting a square foot of drive approach, with the remainder of such cost to be paid by the City.

45  
46 Section 4. The assessment to be levied may be paid in full within thirty (30) days from the levy  
47 thereof in the office of the Director of Finance, and all assessments thereof remaining unpaid at the  
48 expiration of said thirty (30) days shall be certified by the Clerk of Council to the Summit County  
49 Fiscal Officer to be placed by her on the tax duplicate and collected in two (2) semi-annual  
50 installments.

51  
52 Section 5. Notice to the owners thereof shall be given by publishing the resolution establishing  
53 a sidewalk and drive approach repair or replacement district and setting forth the portion of the

54 cost to be assessed, once each week for two weeks in a newspaper published and of general  
55 circulation to the City.  
56

57 Section 6. If an owner objects to an assessment, he shall file his objections in writing with the  
58 Clerk of Council within ten (10) days after the last publication of the resolution as provided in  
59 Section 915.03 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, thereupon, Council shall  
60 consider such objections and if they are found to be well taken, may remit such portion of the  
61 assessment against the property of the objecting owner as is deemed just or may determine by  
62 resolution that a portion or portions of the work described in the ordinance adopted pursuant to  
63 Sections 915.01 or 915.02 shall not be done. Any deficiency arising from such remitter may be  
64 made up from any fund of the City available for the public improvement of streets or by  
65 contributions from the owners desiring that the work be done.  
66

67 Section 7. After the expiration of the time within which objections may be filed under Section  
68 915.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the disposition of objections,  
69 the Director of Public Service may proceed with the work mentioned in Sections 915.01 and 915.02  
70 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of Cuyahoga Falls or if proceeding by contract, the legislative  
71 authority shall authorize the Director of Public Service to advertise and take bids for the awarding  
72 of the necessary contracts subject to any determination by the Council that a portion or portions of  
73 such work shall not be done pursuant to Section 915.04 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of  
74 Cuyahoga Falls.  
75

76 Section 8. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
77 relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that  
78 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its Committees that resulted in such formal action  
79 were in meetings open to the public in compliance with all legal requirements including, to the  
80 extent applicable, Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.  
81

82 Section 9. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
83 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
84 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the  
85 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period  
86 allowed by law.

10 LEASE OF VARIOUS VEHICLES FOR USE BY THE CITY, AND  
11 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

12  
13 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State  
14 of Ohio, that:

15  
16 Section 1. The Directors of Safety or Public Service, as appropriate, are hereby authorized to  
17 enter into contracts for the purchase and/or lease of the vehicles listed on Exhibit A attached  
18 hereto. Notwithstanding and as an exception to Section 181.06 of the Codified Ordinances,  
19 expenditures made under the contracts authorized by this ordinance shall not exceed, in the  
20 aggregate, \$2,924,233.00, without further consent of City Council by ordinance or resolution.

21  
22 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby directed to make payment for same out of  
23 monies lawfully appropriated therefor, from the funds as indicated in Exhibit A.

24  
25 Section 3. Any ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions  
26 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent  
27 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

28  
29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and  
30 relating to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting of this Council and that  
31 all deliberations of this Council and of any committees that resulted in those formal actions were  
32 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107  
33 of the Codified Ordinances.

35 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the  
36 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga  
37 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the  
38 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its  
39 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest  
40 period allowed by law.
