8 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC
9 SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
10 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR THE REPLACEMENT OF A WATERLINE
11 IN 2ND STREET, FROM BROAD BOULEVARD TO MAY AVENUE,
12 AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
15 Ohio, that:

17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
18 contracts, according to law, for the replacement of a waterline in 2nd Street from Broad Boulevard
19 to May Avenue.

21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for
22 same from the Water Fund, line item Capital Outlay.
23

24 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
25 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
26 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
27

28 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
29 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and
30 that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal
31 action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent
32 applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
33

34 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
35 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
36 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the
37 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
38 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest
39 period allowed by law.

8 DIRECTOR OF PUBLIC SAFETY TO ENTER INTO
9 AGREEMENTS WITH VARIOUS CITIES AND TOWNSHIPS
10 FOR THE PROVISION OF PRISONER CONFINEMENT
11 SERVICES, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

14 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
15 and State of Ohio, that:

16
17 Section 1. The Director of Public Safety is hereby authorized to enter into agree-
18 ments with various cities and townships for the provision of prisoner confinement
19 services as availability permits.
20

21 Section 2. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and reso-
22 lutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions
23 or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not
24 previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
25

26 Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council con-
27 cerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting
28 of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees
29 that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance
30 with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
31

32 Section 4. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
33 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
34 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirma-
35 tive vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take
36 effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; other-
37 wise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
