10 FINANCE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR

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20 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of
21 Summit and State of Ohio, that:

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23 Section 1. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
24 or contracts, without competitive bidding, with Wichert Insurance Services, Inc.,
25 on the basis of its proposal dated October 22, 2015, for the professional services
26 necessary to manage the City's risk management and insurance program,
27 including purchase of comprehensive public entity insurance coverages, for a
28 period of one year.
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30 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
31 payment for same from funds properly appropriated to the various departments of
32 the City for these purposes, according to an apportionment of costs as between the
33 departments.
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35 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
36 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
37 resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed
38 are hereby ratified and confirmed.
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40 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
41 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
42 meeting of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
43 committees that resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the
44 public, in compliance with all legal requirements, to the extent applicable,
45 including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.
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47 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure
48 necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and
49 welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, for the reason
50 that it is immediately necessary to purchase public entity insurance coverages,

51 and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the members elected or
52 appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
53 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at
54 the earliest period allowed by law.

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7 ORDINANCE NO. - 2015

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9 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TRAFFIC
10 CONTROL FILE BY PROVIDING FOR INSTALLATION
11 OF VARIOUS TRAFFIC CONTROL DEVICES, AND
12 DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.
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14 WHEREAS, site-specific traffic control regulations of the City are established
15 and maintained in the "Traffic Control File," a document established and
16 maintained by the Chief of Police pursuant to Chapter 305 of the Codified
17 Ordinances, and
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19 WHEREAS, Section 305.02 of said Chapter requires that amendments to the
20 Traffic Control File be made only through legislation passed by City Council.
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22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of
23 Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit, and State of Ohio, that:
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25 Section 1. Upon the recommendation of the Traffic Committee, the Traffic
26 Control File is hereby amended as follows:
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- 28 1. To add signage designating the right westbound lane on Bath Road at
29 State Road a right turn only, the center lane straight only and the left
30 lane a left turn only.
- 31 2. To add signage designating the right northbound lane on State Road
32 at Ascot Parkway a right turn only, the center lane straight only and
33 the left lane a left turn only.
- 34 3. To add signage designating the right northbound lane on State Road
35 at Steels Corners Road a right turn only, the center lane straight only
36 and the left lane a left turn only.
- 37 4. To add signage designating the right westbound lane on Steels
38 Corners Road at State Road a right turn only, the center lane straight
39 only and the left lane a left turn only.
- 40 5. To create center dual left turn lane on State Road from Graham Road
41 to Ascot Parkway.
- 42 6. To add YIELD TO BIKES signage at State Road northbound and
43 southbound at Steels Corners Road, and northbound at Ascot
44 Parkway.
- 45 7. To create left turn lane on Graham Road eastbound at Gilbert Road.
- 46 8. To add the following language to the traffic control file: Install stop
47 sign at the following location: Wellingshire Circle at Howe Avenue.
- 48 9. To prohibit left turn movements out of 2930 State Road.
- 49 10. To restrict parking on Fairview Place from Washington Avenue to the
50 dead end at the business.

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Section 2. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized and directed to note in the Traffic Control File the proper legends.

Section 3. The Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to cause the installation or removal of the proper signage reflecting the above amendments.

Section 4. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed but any ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and which have not been previously repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

Section 5. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified Ordinances.

Section 6. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
