9 AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PARKS AND RECREATION
10 BOARD TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR CONTRACTS,
11 ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR REPLACEMENT OF ASPHALT
12 ROADWAY, REINFORCEMENT AND REPAIR OF SLOPES AND
13 IMPROVEMENT OF STORM WATER STRUCTURES IN BABB RUN
14 PARK, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

16 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit and State of
17 Ohio, that:

18
19 Section 1. The Parks and Recreation Board is hereby authorized to enter into a contract or
20 contracts, according to law, for replacement of asphalt roadway, reinforcement and repair of slopes
21 and improvement of storm water structures in Babb Run Park.

23 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make payment for same
24 from the Recreation Levy Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

26 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions
27 inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent
28 herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.
29

30 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and
31 relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that
32 all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were
33 in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of
34 the Codified Ordinances.

36 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the
37 preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City of Cuyahoga
38 Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote of two thirds of the
39 members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its
40 passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period
41 allowed by law.
