8 PUBLIC SERVICE TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT OR
9 CONTRACTS, ACCORDING TO LAW, FOR OVERHEAD
10 LINE CLEARANCE SERVICES INCLUDING TREE
11 MAINTENANCE, TREE AND BRUSH REMOVAL
12 SERVICES, AND MOWING, FOR A PERIOD NOT TO
13 EXCEED TWO YEARS, AND DECLARING AN
14 EMERGENCY.

16 BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls, County of Summit
17 and State of Ohio, that:

18
19 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a
20 contract or contracts, according to law, for overhead line clearance services, including
21 tree maintenance, tree and brush removal services, and mowing, for a period not to
22 exceed two years.

23
24 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
25 payment for same from the Electric Fund, Line Item Other Operations.

26
27 Section 3. Any other ordinances and resolutions or portions of ordinances and
28 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and
29 resolutions or portions of ordinances and resolutions not inconsistent herewith and
30 which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified and confirmed.

31
32 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
33 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open
34 meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its
35 committees that resulted in such formal action were in meetings open to the public, in
36 compliance with all legal requirements including Chapter 107 of the Codified
37 Ordinances.

39 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
40 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the
41 City of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof and provided it receives the
42 affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall
43 take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor;
44 otherwise it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Cuyahoga Falls,
15 County of Summit and State of Ohio, that:

16
17 Section 1. The Director of Public Service is hereby authorized to enter into a contract
18 or contracts with an engineering firm or firms to provide professional engineering services
19 for the improvements to Barney's Busy Corners.

20
21 Section 2. The Director of Finance is hereby authorized and directed to make
22 payment for same from the Capital Projects Fund, line item Capital Outlay.

23
24 Section 3. Any other ordinances or resolutions or portions of ordinances and
25 resolutions inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, but any ordinances and resolutions
26 not inconsistent herewith and which have not previously been repealed are hereby ratified
27 and confirmed.

28
29 Section 4. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council
30 concerning and relating to the adoption of this ordinance were adopted in an open meeting
31 of this Council, and that all deliberations of this Council and of any of its committees that
32 resulted in such formal action, were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all
33 legal requirements, to the extent applicable, including Chapter 107 of the Codified
34 Ordinances.

36 Section 5. This ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary
37 for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety, convenience and welfare of the City
38 of Cuyahoga Falls and the inhabitants thereof, and provided it receives the affirmative vote
39 of two thirds of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in
40 force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise it shall take effect
41 and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
